- Attendance is not allowed in the following circumstances:
 - \bullet Cold symptoms such as a cough or fever of over 37.5 °C
 - A nearby possible or confirmed case of COVID-19, such as among your family, workplace, school, etc.
 - Feeling unwell (not limited to the restrictions above)
 - Arrival in Japan within the previous 14 days from a country or region with entry restrictions based on the Immigration Control Act

Infection prevention measures

- Temperature checks upon entry. Persons with a fever or other symptoms will not be allowed to attend.
- Seating and attendance limit
 - Attendance limit: limited to 50% of potential capacity
 - Seating: seats will be arranged to maintain distance (minimum 1 meter) between participants
 - Disinfectant: seats, armrests, etc. will be disinfected
- Ventilation
 - Where installed, ventilator fans and A/C systems will be used continuously to provide adequate ventilation.
 - Windows and doors will always be left open when possible. Windows will be opened before and after events.
- ♦ Hand sanitizer
 - Hand sanitizer will be placed at the entrances and exits to event spaces.
- Maintaining distance
 - Attendees will be guided to maintain distance when entering and leaving.
- Event sign-up
- Attendees must apply in advance (to confirm contact information and health condition, etc.).
- Event precautions and announcements on the event day
- Staff will remind attendees of event precautions (coughing manners, masks, etc.) on the day of the event.
- Mask use by staff
 - Staff will wear masks when interacting with attendees (face shields may be used as necessary).
