### Languages and Cultures in Brazil ~A closer look at Brazil's immigrant population and its present influence~



### World Englishes

English is the world's most widely used language in the 21st century.

It is the language of business and education in many countries, the main tool of globalization, and the first choice for cross-culture communication in many situations.

But is English spoken around the world just American or British? Do Australians use the same English as Americans? Do people from South Africa, Canada and India speak the same form of English? What are Shinglish and Chinglish? As English spread around the world it came into contact with local languages. This resulted in new, localized varieties of English. These varieties have come to be known as "World Englishes,". This class will help you learn more about these local varieties of English.

Brazil is a huge country, known for its ethnic and cultural diversity. Being home to significant immigrant populations from every continent, including countries such as Italy, Japan, Poland, Ukraine, as well as several African countries, Brazil is truly a melting pot. Immigrants to Brazil integrate into society and feel a sense of belonging, while not forgetting where they originally came from.

Let's find out how these people established themselves in Brazilian society over the years and settled into their respective regions, influencing this Portuguese-speaking land in an unique way.
