Speech length 5-7 minutes (The jury will ask the contestants questions about the chosen subject after

their speeches).

(1) The completed application form.

*Please record your name, nationality and title before recording the speech.

(3) A copy of the speech manuscript.

Application deadline Must arrive by Wed. July 16, 2014.

Preliminary selection A preliminary selection will be made after an official review of the speeches. The

participants will receive notification of selection by Thur. July 24, 2014.

Judging criteria The relevance of the chosen subject, language proficiency, presentation during the

speech (facial expressions, gestures, body language...), and comprehension of the chosen subject. The content of your speech should not only be your impressions or

thoughts but should also be a statement of your own ideas and opinions.

Prizes The top winner will receive a \(\frac{1}{2}\)50,000 gift voucher and three other winners will receive

a ¥30,000 gift voucher. All other participants will receive a ¥7,000 gift voucher.
