Location: Takamatsu Chuo Park Grass Field

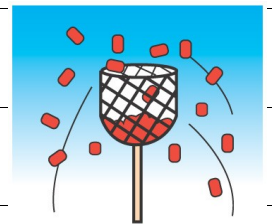
Participation Fee: Free!

Eligibility: Foreigners, Kagawa Residents, Everyone!

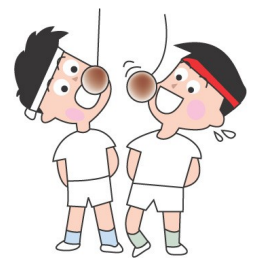
Do you want to get out, run around on grass, and break a sweat together with kids, adults, foreigners, and Japanese people in the cool autumn after noon?
