Bicycle Rentals

Bicycles are available for rental in the central Takamatsu area for 100 yen per day. To rent one, bring an ID (passport, Alien Registration Card, etc.) to one of the rental locations and get a rental card issued. (No charge)

You can rent a bike at one location and return it to another, but you will need to show your card whenever you return the bike, so don't forget it.



*We are conducting the following activities!

"Wa no Kai" is a volunteer group that helps people who have come to live in Kagawa from foreign countries with studying Japanese (should we say Sanuki-ben?), which they need for their daily lives. Our members number 25 people, including housewives, company workers, students, people aspiring to be Japanese teachers, etc. They have gathered here from places throughout Kagawa and have various experiences in society. Regardless of age, they are cooperating together to provide Japanese learning experiences.

Our basic activities usually consist of weekly free classes on Saturdays and study seminars/meetings for our members. When people who wish to study with us cannot attend the free class on Saturday, then they can meet on an individual basis with those members whose time schedules match up, once they have figured out a meeting location together. Though our prospective students have very diverse needs according to their Japanese abilities and the lifestyles of our members can often change, we are prepared to help you in continuing long-term Japanese studies.

This is the 15th year of our language learning activities, and we held course called "Applications in Multicultural Community Building" in April. Also, Japanese Support Classes were begun for students studying abroad at Kagawa University and for students with connections to foreign countries who are attending local schools. We will continue to offer activities that help everyone think about how to live well together in this multicultural age, as local people and people from foreign countries learn how to connect as "Friends and Neighbors."
